Plant performance is based on many factors, and it is important to plan around your site conditions. Plants generally perform best in their native climate, although taking advantage of your site's microclimates can aid in plant performance. We have identified plants that prefer coastal or inland climates throughout this booklet.

These plants are better suited to grow in coastal climates that have cooler overall temperatures and higher humidity, with wet winters and dry summers.



These plants are better suited for inland climates that often experience hot, dry summers with mild winter days and cold nights.

### Acacia 'Desert Carpet'

Prostrate Acacia  $\cdot$  evergreen shrub  $\cdot$  1-2' high x 12-15' wide  $\cdot$  USDA zones 5-11

Fast growing groundcover stays nearly flat to the ground. Foliage is gray-green, narrow, and leathery. Yellow, puff ball flowers in winter to spring.



### Arctostaphylos 'Emerald Carpet'

Emerald Carpet Manzanita · evergreen shrub · 8-14" high x 4-5' wide · USDA zones 7-10 Low, mounding habit makes a compact, dense groundcover. Small, glossy emerald green leaves and clusters of white, urn-shaped flowers.

### Baccharis 'Pigeon Point'

Pigeon Point Dwarf Coyote Brush • evergreen shrub • 2-3' high x 9' wide • USDA zones 8-10 Dense and billowy light green bank cover. Small white flowers bloom in winter.

### Calylophus drummondianus

Sundrops • perennial groundcover • 1' high x 1-2' wide • USDA zones 5-9 A showy perennial groundcover with bright yellow, four-petaled flowers and fuzzy, gray-blue-green foliage. Attracts butterflies and hummingbirds.

### Ceanothus 'Diamond Heights'

Variegated Carmel Creeper California Lilac • evergreen shrub • 1-2' high x 4-6' wide • USDA zones 8-10 A coastal California evergreen shrub with fragrant flower clusters that form a sea of pale blue in spring. Foliage is glossy, oval, 2", and variegated deep green and gold.













### Convolvulus mauritanicus

Ground Morning Glory • evergreen perennial • 2-3' high x 9' wide • USDA zones 8-10 Perennial with fuzzy, gray-green foliage. Funnel-shaped flowers display lavender-blue petals and white centers.

# GROUNDCOVERS

### Dymondia margaretae

Silver Carpet • perennial • 2-3" high x 1-2' wide • USDA zones 9-11 Forms slow-spreading carpet of narrow green leaves with silver undersides. Yellow daisy-like flowers. Provide good drainage.

### Echeveria elegans

Mexican Snowball • succulent perennial • 8" high x 12" wide • USDA zones 9-11

A Mexican succulent that forms lotus-like rosettes of fleshy, slightly cupped leaves in pale shades of jade green, rose and silver.

### Erigeron glaucus 'Cape Sebastian'



Fleabane Daisy • evergreen perennial • 4" high x 3-5' wide • USDA zones 5-8

An evergreen perennial with a low, mounding habit. Medium gray-green leaves are spoon to lance-shaped. Native to coastal California/Oregon.

### Erigeron 'Wayne Roderick'

Seaside Daisy • evergreen perennial • 1' high x 2' wide • USDA zones 7-10 Deep gray-green leaves and lavender-pink flowers. Provide good drainage.



### Grevillea 'Coastal Gem'

Woolly Grevillea • evergreen shrub • 1' high x 4-5' wide •USDA zones 9-11 Low and spreading with woolly, dense, gray-green leaves. Unusual clusters of pink and cream flowers.



### Myoporum parvifolium

Prostrate Myoporum • evergreen shrub • 3-6" high x 8-15' wide • USDA zones 9-10

Dense and low growing shrub with tiny, bright green leaves and white star-shaped flowers. Roots where stems touch soil. Suitable for erosion control.



### Nepeta 'Walker's Low'

Walker's Low Catmint • perennial groundcover • 1-2' high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 4-9 Mounding, cascading form. Graygreen foliage is soft and aromatic. Airy, billowing stalks of lavender-blue flowers in sprint to fall.

### Rosmarinus 'Huntington Carpet'

Rosemary • evergreen shrub • 1-2' high x 6-8' wide • USDA zones 8-10 Aromatic, needle-like leaves. Pale blue flowers. Maintains a dense center and does not become woody.

### Salvia 'Bees' Bliss'

Bee's Bliss Sage · semievergreen • 1-2' high x 4-8' wide • USDA zones 8-10

Dense, mounding perennial with fragrant, silvery-gray-green leaves that produce lavender blue flowers in spring and early summer. Hybrid of two California native sages.

### Scaevola aemula 'Blue Wonder'

Blue Wonder Fan Flower • evergreen perennial • 8-12" high x 1-2' wide • USDA zones 10-11 Trailing, mounding groundcover with bright green, semi-fleshy leaves.

Abundant fan-shaped flowers in violet-blue with yellow eyes from late spring to frost. Attracts pollinators. Heat tolerant.



### Sedum 'Angelina'

Stonecrop • succulent perennial • 3-6" high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 3-11

Needle-like, yellow-green leaves closely set along the stems. Foliage turns orange in cooler weather.



### Senecio mandraliscae

Blue Chalk Sticks • succulent perennial • 12-18" high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 9-11 Blue-green, pencil-like, fleshy leaves. Small and ray-less dull white flowers.

### Senecio serpens

Dwarf Blue Chalksticks • evergreen succulent • 6-12" high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 10-11 Succulent that forms a semi-trailing mat of finger-like leaves that are frosty blue-green with pink tips. White disk flowers bloom in summer. Attracts pollinators.

### Teucrium chamaedrys

Wall Germander • perennial • 8-12" high x 3-5' wide • USDA zones 5-10 Dense, upright semi-woody shrub stays low and tidy. Dark green aromatic foliage with whorls of small, purple-pink flowers in summer. Attracts bees and other pollinators.

### Thymus 'Elfin'

Creeping Thyme • evergreen perennial • 1-2" high x 4-8" wide • USDA zones 4-8

Aromatic, tiny green leaves. Purple flowers. Performs well between stepping stones or as a lawn substitute with light foot traffic.



### Achillea 'Moonshine'

Yarrow • perennial • 2' high x wide • USDA zones 3-9 Ferny, gray-green, aromatic leaves. Flat-topped flower clusters in lemon yellow. Tolerant of drought, wind, and heat.







### Achillea millefolium 'New Vintage White'



Yarrow • perennial • 1' high x 8-12" wide • USDA zones 4-9

Low-growing leaves are ferny, gray to green, and aromatic. Flat-topped, bright white umbel flowers atop clean, 1 foot tall stems.

### Aeonium 'Zwartkop'

Black Rose Aeonium • succulent perennial • 3-4' high x 1-2' wide • USDA zones 9-11 Forms deep reddish-black spoon leafed rosettes at the tips of bare stems. Panicles of vibrant yellow flowers in summer.

### Agastache x 'Kudos Ambrosia'

Hummingbird Mint • herbaceous perennial • 12-18" high x wide • USDA zones 5-9



Fast-growing perennial with aromatic, gray-green foliage. Vertical flower spikes in shades of pale rose and orange. Attracts pollinators.

### Agastache x 'Kudos Silver Blue'

Kudos Dwarf Hummingbird Mint • herbaceous perennial • 12-18" high x wide • USDA zones 5-9 Fast-growing perennial with aromatic, gray-green foliage. Whorled flowers on vertical spikes in shades of light lilacblue. Attracts pollinators.



### Agave 'Blue Glow'

Blue Glow Agave • succulent perennial • 1-2' high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 9-11

Rosettes of upward-arching, steely-blue leaves with serrated, scarlet margins. Mature plants produce tall flower stalks.









### Bouteloua 'Blonde Ambition'

Blue Grama Grass • perennial grass • 1-2' high x wide • USDA zones 3-10

Clump-forming grass with unique flower spikes that attach to stems at a 90° angle. Seed heads emerge chartreuse and mature to blonde.

### Bulbine 'Hallmark'



Orange Stalked Bulbine • succulent perennial • 12" high x 4-5' wide • USDA zones 9-11 Fleshy and gray-green, pencil-like leaves. Bright orange and yellow starry flower clusters.

### Calandrinia spectabilis

Rock Purslane • succulent perennial • 2-3' high x wide • USDA zones 8-10



Clumping growth habit. Fleshy, gray-green leaves. Brilliant magenta flowers bloom year round atop tall, bare stalks.

### Carex divulsa

Berkeley Sedge, European Meadow Sedge • evergreen perennial • 12-18" high x 1-2' wide • USDA zones 4-10 Dark green, grass-like foliage. Roots form dense, broad, arching clumps. Spikes of small flower heads emerge green and turn brown.

### Carex tumulicola

Foothill Sedge • evergreen perennial • 10-12" high x 1-2' wide • USDA zones 4-10



Roots spread to form wide, arching clumps of dark green, grass-like foliage. Spikes of small flower heads.



### Crassula 'Campfire'

Campfire Crassula • succulent shrub • 1' high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 10-11 A succulent shrub with cupped, waxy leaves that mature from green to fiery red. Clusters of flowers bloom in white.

### Dianella revoluta 'Little Rev'

Flax Lily • perennial • 2-3' high x wide • USDA zones 7-11 An evergreen perennial that forms clumps of grass-like foliage. Yellow-green to blue-green leaf blades. Loose clusters of pale violet star-shaped flowers are followed by lustrous purple fruits.

### Diplacus (Mimulus) aurantiacus

Sticky Monkey Flower • herbaceous perennial • 3-4' high x wide • USDA zones 7-10 Narrow, sticky, dark green leaves. Funnel-shaped, two-lipped flowers in golden orange. Summer dormant in hot and dry climates.

### Dudleya brittonii

Britton's Dudleya • succulent • 1-2' high x wide • USDA zones 9-11 Lotus-like rosettes of fleshy leaves are coated in a fine, chalky white powder. Stalks of yellow flowers in spring and summer. Attracts hummingbirds. Native to Baja.



### Echinocactus grusonii

Golden Barrel Cactus • succulent • 1-4' high x wide • USDA zones 9-10

A slow-growing Mexican cactus with a rounded to cylindrical, dark green body and prominent yellow spines. Yellow flowers appear in summer. Produces offsets.



### Epilobium canum

California Fuchsia • herbaceous perennial • 3-5' high x wide • USDA zones 7-10 Felty, gray-green foliage. Trumpet-shaped flowers in bright orange-red.

### Epilobium 'Catalina'

Catalina California Fuchsia • semievergreen shrub • 3-4' high x 4-5' wide • USDA zones 7-10 Dense, mounding shrub with felty, gray-green leaves. Trumpet-shaped flowers in red-orange bloom in summer and fall.

### Eriogonum grande rubescens



Red Buckwheat • woody perennial • 1-2' high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 8-11 Spoon-shaped, gray-green foliage. Rounded clusters of red flowers mature to rusty pale pink.

### Festuca mairei

Atlas Fescue • perennial grass • 2-3' high x wide • USDA zones 4-10

Forms a large fountain-like clump of fine textured yellow-gray leaf blades. Tall stems hold grayish green to amber flower heads.



### Gaura 'Siskiyou Pink'

Siskiyou Pink Gaura • perennial • 2-3' high x wide • USDA zones 5-9 Showy, tall, and airy flowers in shades of maroon to pink. Narrow lance-shaped foliage is tinged with deep red.





### Glandularia (Verbena) 'De La Mina'

Cedros Island Verbena • perennial • 2-3' high x 3' wide • USDA zones 7-11



Bushy and mounding with finely divided bright green leaves. Clusters of lilac-purple flowers.

### Hesperaloe parviflora 'Brakelights'



Brakelights Red Yucca • perennial • 1-2' high x wide • USDA zones 5-10

Perennial with stiff, gray-green leaves with thread-like fringe along margins. Branching inflorescences carry clusters of tubular, bright red flowers over a long season.

### Lavandula 'Goodwin Creek Grey'

Goodwin Creek Grey Lavender • perennial • 2-3' high x wide • USDA zones 7-9

Dense shrub or hedge with silverywhite-green aromatic foliage. Deep purple flower spikes in summer. Evergreen in mild winters.

### Leymus 'Canyon Prince'

Giant Wild Rye • perennial grass • 5-6' high (in flower) x 3-4' wide • USDA zones 7-11 Silvery blue-green leaves. Tall, tancolored flower heads. Hybrid.



### Limonium perezii

Statice • perennial • 2-3' high x wide • USDA zones 10-11 Large and leathery basal leaves. Airy flower clusters in white and purple. Ideal for seaside conditions.





### Lomandra 'Breeze'

Dwarf Mat Rush • evergreen perennial • 2-3' high x 4-5' wide • USDA zones 8-11

Bright green grass-like leaves. Yellow flower spikes among foliage.

### Monardella 'Russian River'

Russian River Coyote Mint • perennial • 12-18" high x wide • USDA zones 6-10 Forms a robust mound of grayish

green, aromatic foliage. Pinkishpurple flowers are arranged in large, showy globes. Attracts butterflies, bees, and hummingbirds.

### Muhlenbergia rigens

Deer Grass • evergreen grass • 4-5' high x 3-4' wide • USDA zones 7-11



Dense, upright to arching fountain of fine-textured, gray-green leaf blades. From late summer through fall, slender flower stalks emerge light purple and age to honey-tan.

### Nepeta x faassenii

Catmint • perennial • 1-2' high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 3-9 Aromatic, soft, gray-green foliage. Loose upright clusters of lavenderblue flowers.



### Penstemon 'Margarita BOP'

Foothill Penstemon • herbaceous perennial • 12-18" high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 6-10



Narrow and linear, blue-green foliage. Upright clusters of flared flowers in purple-blue.



### Salvia apiana

California White Sage • semievergreen • 2-5' high x wide • USDA zones 9-11

Multi-branched shrub with slender, silvery white, velvety leaves that are very aromatic. Attracts pollinators.

### Salvia spathacea

Hummingbird Sage • herbaceous perennial • 12-18" high x 4' wide • USDA zones 8-11



Low and spreading perennial with fuzzy, arrow-shaped, light green leaves. Flower spikes carry whorls of magenta-red flowers.

### Setcreasea pallida (Tradescantia)

Purple Heart • perennial • 8-18" high x wide • USDA zones 7-11

A tender perennial that forms an upright mat with thick, trailing, purple stems. Purple leaves are slender and pointed. Pink three-petaled flowers Mexico.

### Stachys byzantina

Lamb's Ear • perennial • 6-12" high x 1-2' wide • USDA zones 4-10 A perennial that forms a dense mat of mounding rosettes. Velvet-soft leaves are silver-green and tongue-shaped with serrated edges. Purple-pink two-lipped flowers arise in spike-like clusters in late spring or summer.



### Acacia 'Cousin Itt'

Little River Wattle • evergreen shrub • 2-3' high x 4-6' wide • USDA zones 9-11 Low and mounding form with dense, linear, weeping foliage in bright green.



### Adenanthos sericeus

Coastal Woollybush • evergreen shrub • 6-10' high x 4-6' wide • USDA zones 9-10 Upright shrub with silky-soft, silvery-green, needle-like foliage. Insignificant red flowers appear sporadically throughout the year. Do not fertilize with phosphorus.

### Arctostaphylos 'Howard McMinn'

Manzanital • evergreen shrub • 6-10' high x wide • USDA zones 7-10 Rounded form with reddish



Rounded form with reddish branches and bright green leaves. Clusters of pale pink flowers.

### Arctostaphylos 'Pacific Mist'

Pacific Mist Manzanita • woody evergreen shrub • 2-3' high x 6-15' wide • USDA zones 8-10 Dense, rounded shrub with upright, red-brown branchlets. Small, graygreen leaves and sparse clusters of white, urn-shaped flowers.

### Callistemon 'Little John'

Dwarf Bottlebrush • evergreen shrub • 3-5' high x 4-6' wide • USDA zones 8-11 Dense branches covered in bluegreen leaves. Red bristle-like flowers.



### Carpenteria californica

Bush Anemone • evergreen shrub • 5-7' high x 3-4' wide • USDA zones 8-10 Leathery, lance-shaped leaves. Fragrant white flowers with vellow stamens.



### Ceanothus 'Joyce Coulter'

Creeping Mountain Lilac • evergreen shrub • 2-5' high x 10-12' wide • USDA zones 7-10 A fast-growing evergreen shrub with a low and arching habit. Fragrant clusters of lavender blue flowers in spring. Leathery, medium green foliage. Good on slopes.

### Ceanothus 'Yankee Point' Yankee Point California Lilac • evergreen shrub • 2-3' high x 8-10' wide • USDA zones 8-10 A fast-growing, low and spreading shrub with rich blue, fragrant flower clusters in spring. Foliage is glossy, oval, and deep green.

### Chondropetalum tectorum

Cape Reed • marsh plant • 3-5' high x wide • USDA zones 8-10 Compact plant with upright jointed, matte blue-green stems with papery bracts in hues of cream, rust, scarlet, and brown. Dark brown flower heads grow at tips of foliage.

### Cistus x purpureus

Orchid Rockrose • evergreen shrub • 4-6' high x wide • USDA zones 8-10



Bright pink, papery petals with dark burgundy spots. Narrow, gray-green, resinous foliage.



### Cistus 'Sunset'

Magenta Rockrose  $\cdot$  evergreen shrub  $\cdot$  2-3' high x 6-8' wide  $\cdot$  USDA zones 8-10

Single flowers display bright magenta, crepe-paper petals and golden stamens. Leaves are narrow, woolly, and gray-green. Tolerates heat, poor soil, and seaside conditions. Attracts butterflies.



### Correa 'Wyn's Wonder'

Wyn's Wonder Australian Fuchsia • evergreen shrub • 2-3' high x 4-5' wide • USDA zones 9-10 Dense shrub with bell-shaped, apple-red flowers that are most abundant from late fall to spring. Oval, variegated leaves are graygreen with creamy yellow margins.

### Dodonaea viscosa 'Purpurea'



Purple Leaved Hopseed Bush • evergreen shrub • 10-15' high x wide • USDA zones 8-11

Bronzy-green willow-like foliage turns burgundy-red in cooler weather. Pink papery seed pods.

### Echium fastuosum

Pride of Madeira • evergreen shrub • 4-6' high x 6-10' wide • USDA zones 9-11

Self-sowing shrub with large spikelike stalks of small lavender-blue flowers. Whorled leaves are hairy, lance-shaped, and gray-green. Does well in coastal gardens.

### Frangula (Rhamnus) californica

Coffeeberry • evergreen shrub • 6-10' high x 6-8' wide • USDA zones 7-10

Versatile, tidy shrub makes a great hedge. Glossy, deep green leaves. Large red to black berries.





### Frangula (Rhamnus) 'Leatherleaf'

Leatherleaf Coffeeberry · evergreen shrub · 5-8' high x wide · USDA zones 7-10



Forms a neat mound of dark green, leathery leaves. Small, white flowers are followed by reddish black berries in the fall.







### Grevillea 'Noelli'

Noell Grevillea • evergreen shrub • 4-5' high x wide • USDA zones 8-11 An open and rounded evergreen shrub with dark green, needle-like foliage. Brush-like clusters of long and curved flowers in rosy red.

### Heteromeles arbutifolia

Toyon • evergreen shrub • 10-15' high x 6-8' wide • USDA zones 7-10

Dark green and leathery, toothed leaves. Clusters of white flowers followed by small red berries in the fall and winter.

### Lantana 'Confetti'

Confetti Spreading Lantana • evergreen shrub • 2-3' high x 6-8' wide • USDA zones 9-11



Heat-loving and vigorous. Flower clusters in yellow, pink, and purple attract hummingbirds and bees from late spring to fall.

### Olea 'Little Ollie'

Dwarf Olive • evergreen shrub • 4-6' high x wide • USDA zones 8-11 Excellent low hedge with narrow, gray-green foliage. Does not produce fruit.













### Phlomis fruticosa

Jerusalem Sage • perennial shrub • 3-4' high x 3-4' wide • USDA zones 7-10 An upright Mediterranean shrub with soft, gray-green foliage and whorls of bright lemon yellow flowers.

### SHRUBS

### Portulacaria afra 'Variegata'

Rainbow Bush • succulent shrub • 8-12' high x 4-6' wide • USDA zones 9-11 Small, minty-green and creamy-white leaves stand out on thick, dark red stems. Requires excellent drainage. Stays small in containers, excellent for bonsai. Occasional summer flowers.

### Rosmarinus 'Tuscan Blue'

Tuscan Blue Rosemary • evergreen shrub • 4-6' high x 2-4' wide • USDA zones 8-11 Upright, semi-columnar shrub with tiny, lavender blue flowers. Favored selection for culinary use.

### Salvia clevelandii 'Winnifred Gilman'



California Blue Sage • evergreen shrub • 3-5' high x 3-5' wide USDA zones 8-10

Gray-green leaves are small, almost linear, and intensely fragrant. Dark maroon stalks carry buds. Blooms in late spring and summer.

### Teucrium 'Azureum'

Bush Germander • semi-woody evergreen shrub • 3-4' high x wide • USDA zones 8-10 Silvery green, aromatic foliage. Bright purple-blue flowers.

### Westringia 'Morning Light'

Coast Rosemary • evergreen shrub • 3-4' high x 4-5' wide • USDA zones 9-10

Gray-green and white variegated foliage. Small white star-shaped flowers.



### Arbutus x 'Marina'

Strawberry Tree  $\cdot$  evergreen tree  $\cdot$  25-40' high x wide  $\cdot$  USDA zones 7-9



Broad, dense crown with leathery, dark green leaves. Clusters of pink flowers followed by bright orange-red fruits. Exfoliating reddish bark.



### **Brachychiton populneus**

Bottle Tree • evergreen tree • 30-50' high x 25-30' wide • USDA zones 9-11 Tree with a heavy, tapered trunk and shimmering green leaves. Woody seed pods follow small bell-shaped flowers.

### Cedrus deodara

Deodar Cedar • evergreen conifer • 40-80' high x 20-40' wide • USDA zones 7-9 Conifer with a fast, tall, pyramidal growth habit. Horizontal branches display upright cones and gray-green needles.

### Cercidium x 'Desert Museum'

Palo Verde • deciduous tree • 20-25' high x wide • USDA zones 6-9 Open and airy form with bright green trunk and branches. Yellow flowers.

### Cercis occidentalis

Western Redbud • deciduous tree • 10-18' high x wide • USDA zones 6-9 Bright pink flowers bloom



on bare branches in early spring, followed by broad, heart-shaped leaves.













### Chitalpa 'Pink Dawn'

Pink Dawn Chitalpa • deciduous tree • 20-30' high x wide • USDA zones 6-8

Fast-growing tree with frilly pink trumpet-shaped flowers. Bright green linear leaves. TREES

### Erythrina coralloides

Naked Coral Tree • deciduous tree • 25-30' high x wide • USDA zones 9-10

Bizzare branching form makes this a handsome specimen, with or without foliage and flowers. Fiery red candlestick-like flowers bloom at the tips of twisting, thorny branches from February to June. Native to Mexico.

### Geijera parviflora

Australian Willow •



evergreen tree • 25-30' high x 20' wide • USDA zones 9-11 Graceful and weeping form with narrow, silvery-green, willow-like leaves. Tiny clusters of white and yellow flowers.

### Lagerstroemia 'Tuscarora'

Crape Myrtle · deciduous tree · 15-20' high x wide · USDA zones 6-9 Bright rosy-pink flower clusters. Oval green leaves turn red-orange in the fall. Bark exfoliates with age. Mildew resistant hybrid.

### Olea 'Swan Hill'

Swan Hill Olives® Tree • evergreen tree • 20-30' high x wide • USDA zones 8-10

Slow growing evergreen tree with light gray bark and gray-green foliage. Certified fruitless variety, rarely produces pollen or fruit.

### Pinus torreyana

Torrey Pine • coniferous tree • 40-60' high x 30-50' wide • USDA zones 8-10 A coniferous tree with an irregular, broad habit. Light gray-green long needles line branches, dark brown ovoid cones in winter. Native to Southern California. TREES



### Pistacia chinensis 'Red Push'

Chinese Pistache • deciduous tree • 25-35' high x wide • USDA zones 6-9 Deep green, divided foliage turns bright orange-red in the fall.



### Quercus agrifolia

Coast Live Oak • evergreen tree • 20-70' high x wide • USDA zones 7-10 Broad and dense crown with thick, leathery, dark green leaves. Bark becomes furrowed and dark gray with age.

### Quercus engelmannii

Engelmann Oak • evergreen tree 50-65' high x 80-120' wide • USDA zones 8-10

Moderately fast-growing with rounded, spreading form and leathery, bluishgreen leaves. Light grayish-brown bark is furrowed and scaly, the trunk becomes more gnarled and twisted with age.

### Quercus suber

Cork Oak • evergreen tree • 30-70' high x wide • USDA zones 8-10 Leathery green leaves are eggshaped with spiny, rolled under edges. Bark becomes corky, furrowed, and dark gray-brown with age.

### Searsia (Rhus) lancea

African Sumac • evergreen tree • 20-30' high x wide • USDA zones 9-11 Spreading, umbrella crown with reddish brown, fissured bark. Arching branches and weeping, dark green, willow-like foliage.





### Bougainvillea 'Barbara Karst'

Bougainvillea • evergreen vine • climbs 15-30' • USDA zones 10-11 Shrubby vine with displays clusters of showy magenta bracts, which surround tiny true flowers. Medium green leaves are oval to heart-shaped.



### Clytostoma callistegoides

Lavender Trumpet Vine • evergreen vine • climbs 20' • USDA zones 9-11 An evergreen climbing vine with longblooming, trumpet-shaped flowers of lavender purple. Foliage is dense, glossy, and dark green.

### Ficus pumila repens

Creeping Fig • evergreen vine • climbs 30-40' • USDA zones 9-11 A tropical vine with a vigorous, selfclinging habit using aerial rootlets. Young leaves are heart-shaped, delicate, and light green, maturing to larger, elliptic, leathery, and dark green.

### Gelsemium sempervirens

Carolina Jessamine • evergreen vine climbs 15-20' • USDA zones 7-10 An evergreen vine with shiny, light green leaves and yellow trumpetshaped flowers.

### Hardenbergia 'Happy Wanderer'

Purple Lilac Vine • evergreen vine • climbs 10-15' • USDA zones 9-11 Pendulous clusters of purple flowers resemble small Wisteria blooms. Narrow, dark green foliage.
